To enhance children's creativity and innovation for the progressive learning. Help your child to do the following:

1. Morning Blessings: help your child inculcate good habits like 'doing surya pranam' and encourage him/her to greet all elders in the morning.
2. Fun in knowing: Tell the child about your childhood, share incidents from the past and show them old family albums. This will strengthen the bond between you and your child.
3. Fun with books: Read English and Hindi stories to your child with morals.
4. Fun with Family: Make use of these holidays and spend quality time together as a family and make your child feel special.
5. Fun with parents: Cook dinner together, show your child how to measure 1 cup, 1/2 teaspoon etc. Start naming the food groups, when you serve them.

7. Have walk together and talk to your child about what they like and dislike etc.

8. Help your child to memorize the home address and your phone numbers too.
9. Help your child in learning how to open and close his/her water bottle, lunch box & school bag.

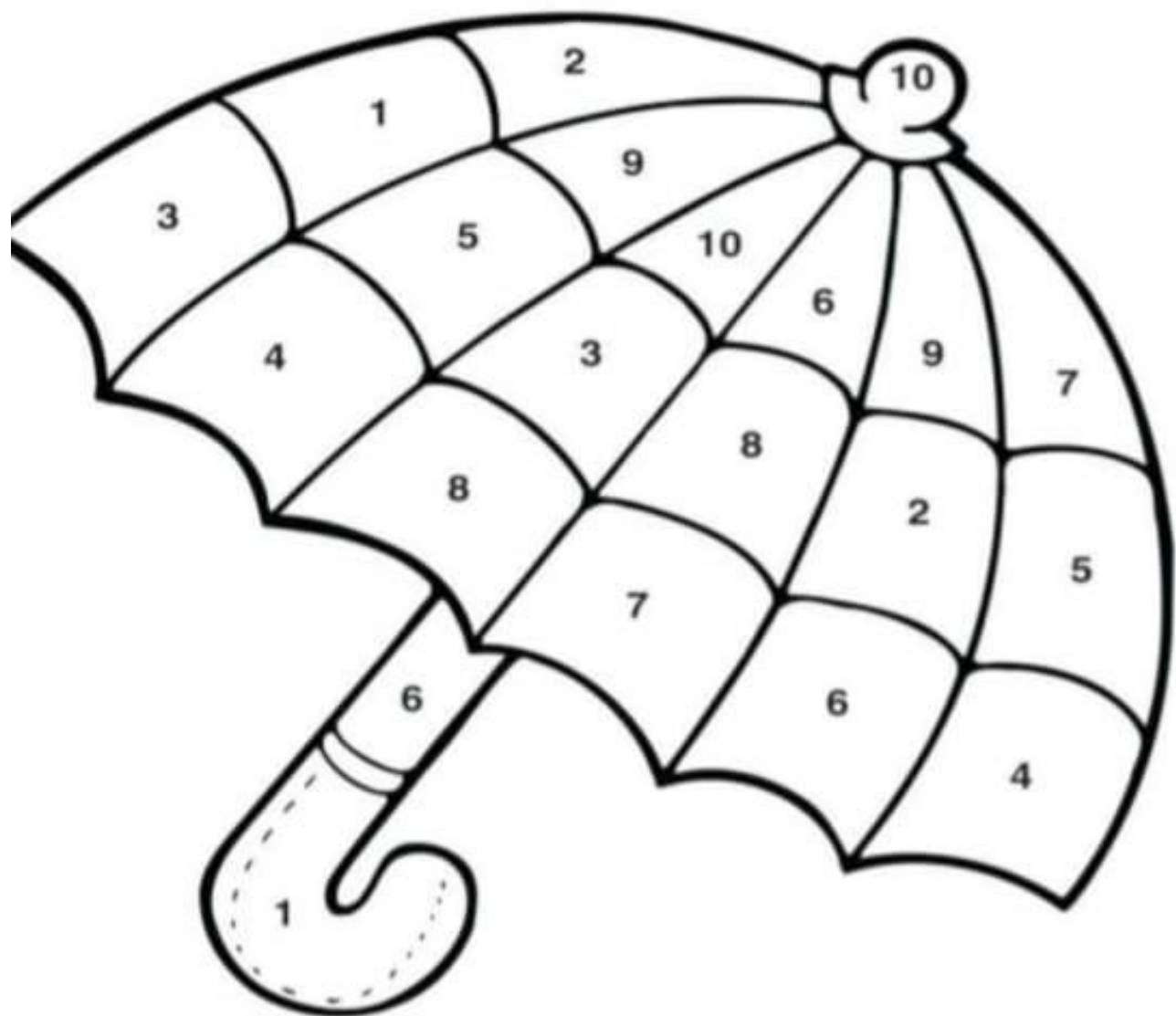
